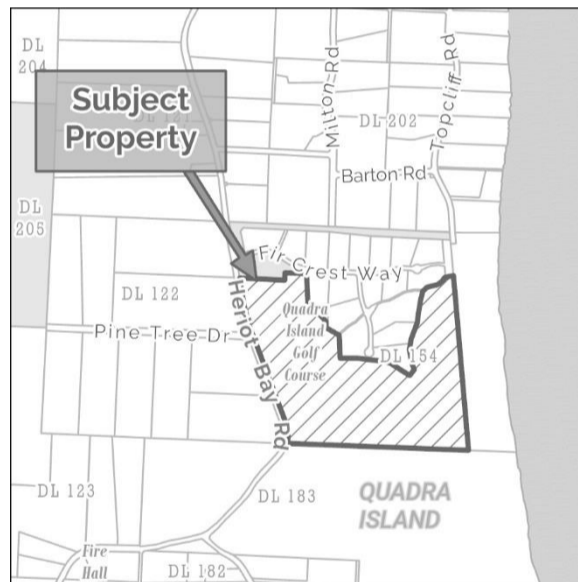

**Public Hearing for Bylaw Nos. 432 and 433 to commence at:** 7:00 p.m.

**Area affected by proposed Bylaw Nos. 432 and 433:** The subject area is legally described as Lot 2, District Lots 122 and 154, Sayward District, Plan 36442, Exc. Part in Plans VIP75891 and EPP98484, as shown on the map below.

**Purpose of proposed Bylaw Nos. 432 and 433:** Bylaw No. 432, if adopted, would amend the Recreation Commercial designation on the subject parcel to include associated secondary accessory recreational vehicle site uses. Bylaw No. 433, if adopted, would amend the Recreation Commercial One (RC-1) zone to include recreational vehicle sites as a permitted accessory use of land, subject to Conditions of Use as laid out in the proposed amendment to the zoning bylaw.



Copies of the proposed bylaws and related information are available for inspection by appointment at the Strathcona Regional District Customer Service Centre, located at #102 – 990 Cedar Street, Campbell River, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, from January 5, 2022 until 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, January 19, 2022. The public hearing will be held by a delegation of Electoral Area directors representing the Strathcona Regional District Board. Individuals attending the hearing in person will be afforded the opportunity to be heard during the comments portion of the hearing.
