



NOTICE OF ADVANCE ELECTOR REGISTRATION 2022 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that, in accordance with section 71 of the *Local Government Act*, advance registration of electors will close at 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 23, 2022 for voting in the 2022 general local elections for the following positions:

- Director, Electoral Area A (Kyuquot/Nootka-Sayward) – one position
- Director, Electoral Area B (Cortes Island) – one position
- Director, Electoral Area C (Discovery Islands-Mainland Inlets) – one position
- Director, Electoral Area D (Oyster Bay-Buttle Lake) – one position

RESIDENT ELECTORS

To register as a resident elector a person must meet the following qualifications:

- Canadian Citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on October 15, 2022;
- resident of the electoral area for which registration is being sought;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months at the time of registration; and
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Persons wishing to register in advance as resident electors for voting in the 2022 general local elections may do so by contacting Elections BC toll-free at 1-800-661-8683 or by using the online voter registration system at www.elections.bc.ca/ovr. As of August 17, 2022 persons wishing to register in advance as resident electors may only do so by contacting the Chief Election Officer or Deputy Chief Election Officer for the Strathcona Regional District. Following the close of advance registration persons may only apply to register at the time of voting.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS

To register as a non-resident property elector a person must meet the following qualifications:

- Canadian Citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on October 15, 2022;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months at the time of registration;
- registered owner of real property within the relevant electoral area for at least 30 days immediately preceding registration;
- not qualified to register as a resident elector of the electoral area; and
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Persons wishing to register in advance as non-resident property electors may do so by contacting the Chief Election Officer or Deputy Chief Election Officer for the Strathcona Regional District. Following the close of advance registration persons may only apply to register at the time of voting.

DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS

Persons wishing to register to vote as a resident elector or non-resident property elector must provide, at the time of registration, at least 2 documents as evidence of their identity and place of residence, at least one of which must contain the applicant's signature. Applicants will also be required to make a solemn declaration before an election official regarding their place of residence.

PUBLIC INSPECTION OF LISTS OF ELECTORS

The lists of registered electors for voting in the 2022 general local elections will be available for public inspection during regular office hours from 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, August 30, 2022 until the close of voting on Saturday, October 15, 2022. Persons wishing to inspect a list of electors must first sign a statement that the person will not do so except for the purposes of the voting process. In order to protect the privacy or security of an elector the Chief Election Officer will, upon receiving a written request from that elector, amend the list that is to be made available for public inspection by redacting the address of the elector or other information about the elector.

OBJECTIONS TO REGISTRATION OF ELECTOR


Objections to the registration of a person as an elector may be made by qualified electors until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, September 9, 2022. Objections may only be made on the basis that the elector has died or that the person is not qualified to be registered as an elector of the relevant electoral area.

SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTOR REGISTRATION

Persons who register to vote in a Regional District director election within the boundaries of School District 72 or School District 84 are automatically entitled to vote in elections for school trustee for the relevant area and do not need to register separately for those elections.
